Pool News

Guest Policy. The trustees believe the pool is for the enjoyment of all residents and their guests. Therefore, we do not set a guest limit per day or per season. Having said that, we do ask residents that plan to have 10 or more guests, using the pool, to contact Metropolitan Pools and make arrangements for an extra lifeguard. This allows for the continued safety of all residents using the pool. Metropolitan Pools can be reached at 216-741-9451. The rate for lifeguards is \$20/ hour during regular pool hours. If you have any questions, concerning this policy, please contact one of your trustees or the pool committee.

Hot Dog Fridays. Support the swim team and purchase hot dogs and/ or pizza on Friday's for lunch from noon-2PM.

Wristbands. Please remember to use your wristbands. They identify you as a Hawthorn of Aurora resident. If you need wristbands or have any other questions, concerning the pool, please contact Jim Barto, Wendy Wilk, or Laura Duguay. We hope everyone is enjoying the pool this summer.

Lost and Found. Please remember to take your belongings home with you. Another "lost and found" event will be held later this summer for the items that are left at the pool. Any leftovers will be donated.



Clubhouse News

We have recently implemented a new reservation system for our clubhouse and pavilion. You can actually make your reservation (vs. request it and then wait for confirmation from KareCondo). You will automatically receive a reminder, via email, 21 days prior to your event. You will also receive the clubhouse keypad code, via email, 5 days prior to your event.

The reservation system link is on our webpage, www.hawthornofaurora.com. Click on link for Clubhouse/ Pavilion Reservation System.

As part of the implementation of this system, we are eliminating the need for deposit checks and payment before your event. All rentals will be invoiced for unpaid balances following the event. This may include additional cleaning fees, if cleaning is not done, per the rental agreement.

Please make sure to read the rules for rentals and reservations, when you book an event. Party signs and/or balloons are not permitted on the common property. There are directional/ way-finding signs to the clubhouse and also a sign at the entrance island to the recreation center area. This should be sufficient for guests to find their way to our facilities. Anyone posting signs or balloons may be assessed \$25.



Reminder: No Advertising Signs

Our Covenants and Restrictions prohibit the placement of signs or other advertising devices in your yard. Please inform your contractors that placement of signs is not permitted. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Boat Ramp Parking:

Please park on the grass (at an angle) when parking cars, at the boat ramp area. Do not park on the paved areas. This is needed for turnaround space for boaters putting their boats into the lake.
