Lake/ Boating News

As we are approaching the end of the boating season, please read below for key dates. Please let John Milner know if you can help with some work required for the removal/ building of new docks.

- All boats need to be removed from the docks by midnight, Monday, Oct 12th.
- The docks will be repaired, power-washed and stained beginning Tuesday, October 13th. This will be completed before the docks are removed.
- We need volunteers to build two new dock sections to add to Pier C (far right dock). The building date is planned for Saturday, October 17th, beginning at 9:00am. This is the final build and will add two additional boat slips, bringing the total dock slips to 40. Building skills and tools will be appreciated.
- Dock removal is planned for Saturday, October 31st, beginning at 9:00am. We will again rent the fork lift, but we still need people to remove hardware, float docks in and help swing them into place. This job can be accomplished in less than 3 hours when we have at least 15 volunteers.
- We have a waiting list for dock slips so if you want a dock slip for the 2016 season you will need to drop off a \$50.00 deposit to John Milner (676 Rock Creek Drive) by December 1st, 2015. Please make checks payable to Hawthorn of Aurora Homeowners Association.
- Steve Milano, who many of the boaters know, is a bit of a mad scientist (he is a senior scientist for Tremco). Steve has never been impressed with the current hull cleaners on the market, so he developed his own. If you plan on cleaning your own boat, contact Steve and ask him about his new HC-1 Hull Cleaner. Also, boaters, your boat cannot be "stored" in your driveway, per our Covenants and Restrictions. Once the lake is closed for the season, boats should be removed from driveways and "stored off site" for the winter season.
