

Aurora Lake Permit(s) Application Form (2024)

Summary: As stated in the Aurora Lake Association (ALA) Rules and Regulations (find the most current version at www.auroralakeassociation.com), by placing and operating a watercraft on Aurora Lake, a proper Lake Access Permit Application must be provided including, all requested information, proof of insurance, required fees, and other appropriate requirements. Once a completed and proper application has been provided to the Aurora Shores Homeowners Association (ASHA), or Hawthorn of Aurora Homeowners Association HHOA), ALA can provide authorization and an Aurora Lake Boat Permit (Sticker) granting permission to operate your watercraft upon Aurora Lake.

Agreement: I, the undersigned owner, acknowledge that I, for myself, my heirs and my representatives have read and understand the ASHA, or HHOA, and ALA lake specific Rules and Regulations (find the most current version at www.auroralakeassociation.com) as they pertain to the operation of a watercraft upon Aurora Lake and the authority and regulations of Aurora Lake Association, and agree to be bound by the terms and conditions thereof. I, for myself, my heirs, and my representatives understand and agree that I am required to meet ODNR, or Aurora Lake Rules and Regulations boating course requirements for myself, my heirs, and representatives and by my signature confirm that I myself, my heirs, or representatives have met such obligations.

I, for myself, my heirs, and representatives acknowledge the existence and jurisdiction of the ALA Lake Patrol and its authority to enforce said Aurora Lake specific Rules and Regulations of ALA and the Ohio Watercraft Laws. I, for myself, my heirs, and representatives, hereby agree to defend, indemnify, and save ALA, HHOA and ASHA harmless from any and all claims, demands, actions, fines, penalties, liabilities, damage, expense, and loss of any kind whatsoever (including reasonable attorney’s fees and costs), including but not limited to claims for personal injury, bodily injury, loss of life, or property damage to any person or entity (including, but not limited to my, my family, invitees, guests, and agents, as well as any other boater or user of Aurora Lake and other persons situated on or adjoining the lake premises), arising out of or in the connection with the use of Aurora Lake, or its channels, or facilities.

Further, I understand and agree that boating and the operation of watercraft is dangerous and can result in injury, death, and/or property damage to myself, and/or others and that I, for myself, my heirs, and representatives, and hereby assume all associated risks and further waive, release, and forever discharge any claims, legal, or equitable, known or unknown, foreseeable or unforeseeable, against ALA, Hawthorn of Aurora Homeowners Association (HHOA), and/or ASHA for injury and/or damage at or on Aurora Lake. All used in this Application Form for any purpose, the terms ALA, HHOA, and ASHA shall include the Lake Patrol, and their respective trustees, officers, members, employees, agents, or invitees.

By my signature, I acknowledge the agreement, and as stated above.

If you are a renter, you must obtain written approval from your landlord to register a boat.

Note: An Owner who rents a property cannot have lake privileges, as the rights to the amenities pass to the lessee.

Renter – Written Approval

1. The term “Homeowner” includes a homeowner in residence in HHOA or ASHA, and also includes a lessee of a condominium unit, cluster unit, or freestanding house in HHOA or ASHA.
2. A lessee of a condominium unit, cluster unit, or freestanding house may register and operate a Watercraft on Aurora Lake only with prior written approval from the Owner of the condominium unit, cluster unit, or freestanding house.
3. The written approval must be renewed annually.
4. The lessee must comply with all registration, title, and insurance requirements in the ALA Rules and Regulations. The title to the Watercraft must be in the name of the lessee.
5. An Owner who rents a property cannot have lake privileges, as the rights to the amenities pass to the lessee.

By signing below, the Owner: (1) affirms that the named Lessee is a current tenant of the identified property address, and (2) provides written approval for the named Lessee to register and operate a Watercraft on Aurora Lake.
